## **\*GETTING THERE\***

### **Emergency Contact for Travel Days**

If you are delayed and will miss a flight, contact STI so that we may communicate the new information to our local representatives. For communication in Ecuador, to avoid high costs or limited cell phone coverage, we recommend using Wifi and Whatsapp. Whatsapp is an app available on both iOS and Android and is widely used in Ecuador. To make calls with this app, you need to save the Contact name and phone number in your standard contact list, so we recommend you do this prior to the trip.

### **Insurance**

If you have not purchased travel insurance for this trip, there is still time to purchase, as it will cover any emergency medical needs or other covered concerns that may arise while you are overseas. Please email Nancy at [nweeks@singlestravelintl.com](mailto:nweeks@singlestravelintl.com) today to get a quote for a trip protection package. It’s more reasonable than you think!

**Make sure you take a copy of your policy and emergency and contact phone numbers with you in case you need assistance. Travel Insurance is a new requirement for entering Ecuador. This has not been enforced yet, but it is best to be prepared as they might ask for proof of insurance prior to entry.**

## **Passports & Visas**

A passport is mandatory for this trip. Be sure to confirm that your passport is current and will be valid at least six months after your departure (July 2, 2019). If you do not have one or need a new one, U.S. guests may contact the State Department Passport Office in your area immediately or visit <http://www.travel.state.gov/>.

Always carry a copy of the first page of your passport with your photo during your visit. Upon arrival you will have received a tourist card to fill out from the airline (prior to landing) at no additional charge, which should be carried along with your passport at all times. You will need your tourist card for trip extensions, passport checks and to depart the country. U.S. and Canadian citizens are not required to carry a Visa in Ecuador. In addition to your passport and tourist card you “officially” need a ticket out of the country, although they rarely ask to see it.

It is always a good idea when traveling to have a photocopy of the important pages of your passport kept separate, in case it is lost or stolen. Note that you are required by law to carry your passport with you at all times. On the back of the photocopy, it wouldn't hurt to list emergency phone numbers, as well as the numbers listed on your traveler's checks, airline tickets, credit cards, etc. It would also be wise to photocopy your airline ticket and insurance policies. Keep these copies in a separate place other than your security travel wallet. We recommend that you leave this information in a safe place in your room at the Inn. Chances are you won't have to use any of these, but it sure makes life easier if something is lost. In addition, you should leave a photocopy of all of these documents, as well as your itinerary and any contact numbers you're aware of at home with a friend or family member. Note that you should always lock your door in your hotel and ask about a safe for your important documents, such as credit cards and/or travelers checks.

## **Local Transportation**

Our package includes airport transfers and a guide will meet you at the Airport. After exiting customs, a driver or guide will be waiting with a sign with your name. Your guide will take you to the hotel where you will meet your fellow travelers.

If you are staying additional nights in Quito, it is recommended that you work with your hosts, the hotel or other trusted resources to arrange additional transportation.

## **Airport**

If we've made your flight arrangements, you received an e-ticket confirmation at the time of booking. **At the airport**, remember you may change your original seat assignment, and this is the best time to do it for all flights continuing on the same day. Verify that the airline has a record of your frequent flier number on the reservation. Abide by the airline's carry-on luggage restrictions,

and note that all liquids, gels and aerosols must be in three-ounce or smaller containers. Larger containers that are half-full or toothpaste tubes rolled up are not allowed. All items must be stored in a clear, 1 quart, zip lock bag.

### **Baggage**

We recommend that you visit your carrier’s website or call them directly for up-to-date information about baggage allowance, weight restrictions and fees. Please abide by the carry-on luggage restrictions. All liquids, gels and aerosols must be in three-ounce or smaller containers. Larger containers that are half-full or toothpaste tubes rolled up are not allowed. All items must be stored in a clear, 1 quart, zip lock bag.

Just in case your luggage is lost, we strongly recommend that you pack a change of clothing in your carry-on luggage. Do not pack money, travel documents, jewelry or medicine in your checked baggage. Hand carry these essential items!

### **Flight Schedule**

Most Airlines now offer online check in for international flights 24 hours in advance. Airlines recommend that you check in at least 2-3 hours prior for an international departure and require you to present a valid passport. Please abide by the carry-on luggage restrictions.

***Important Note: Proof of citizenship is mandatory. To enter Ecuador, foreign travelers need a passport that is valid for at least six months after departure, (July 2, 2019)***

# \*GENERAL INFORMATION\*

## Communication

Wi-Fi will be available at each hotel location but phone calls are subject to additional charges. Ecuador & the Galapagos Islands have both GSM and CDMA networks for use of personal mobile phones, but coverage can be limited while on excursions in the mountains, beaches or other remote areas.

## Time

Ecuador Continental territory is on Eastern Standard Time (GMT -5). Galapagos Islands is on Central Standard Time (GMT -6). There is no Daylight Savings Time.

## Electricity

110 volts, 60 cycles, AC. Plugs have two flat prongs, the same as in North America.

## Money/Exchange

The currency used throughout our trip is the US Dollar. **Each guest will need to bring cash for payment of their Galapagos Island Entrance Fee (\$100) and Visitor Card (\$20) and payment**

for personal spending, snacks, drinks and shopping. For incidentals and small vendors, it is recommended to have US dollars in small denominations, \$1, \$5, \$10 and \$20 bills that are not too old, worn or ripped.

Some locations will accept major credit cards and have ATMs available. If bringing a credit card, it is a good idea to notify your credit card provider that you will be making international charges to avoid potential problems. It is best to bring between \$300-\$500 in cash and your ATM card. Please note that debit cards from local community banks or credit unions without the Visa or Mastercard, typically do not work on the ATM machines. Traveler checks and Bank checks are not the ideal way to travel because it usually takes 1-2 hours to wait at an Ecuadorian bank to deliver the funds. Be sure to change traveler's checks in Quito.

### **Weather and Attire**

Weather in Tumbaco is similar year-round, with warm sunny days giving way to cool nights. Our resort enjoys the perfect weather with 60's in the early morning and nighttime, but reaches temperatures of 75-80 during the daytime, all year round.

Our excursions will take the group on sunny canyon walks, into the misty cloud rain forest, and to a windy 14,000 ft. Rain is a possibility throughout the week, varies year to year and can make cool evenings feel chillier. Due to the high altitude, the sun on clear days can feel more intense. So be prepared to experience a range of temperatures and climates with comfortable layered clothing.

### **What to Pack and Suggested Attire**

- A good, comfortable pair of walking shoes or light hiking shoes
- A pair of shoes for restaurants (loafers, sandals, etc...)
- A pair of comfortable sandals for walking and beach wear, or a pair of water shoes if desired.
- 2-3 pairs of lightweight pants or shorts for walking or light hiking
- Lightweight layered tops. A very lightweight long sleeve top provides great protection from the sun, and great for walks in the cooler highlands areas.
- A swimsuit
- Light jacket, fleece, hoodie or light sweater for cool evenings
- Lightweight raingear or poncho in case of rain
- Sunglasses, sun block (30 or higher for face), sun hat, baseball cap or visor. The heat will likely not be intense, but Quito and the Galapagos are along the Equator and sun protection is important every day!
- Toiletries: all your daily essentials
- Prescription medications: sufficient supply for the entire trip plus legible written prescription in case of loss. Keep medications in their original, labeled container. Always pack your medications in your carry-on bag!
- Eyeglasses, contacts, contact lens solution. You may want to bring along a written prescription for your eyewear in case of loss.

- Over the counter medications: cold remedy, aspirin/pain reliever, antacid/stomach upset remedy, Band-Aids, anti-bacterial medication, Dramamine (if prone to motion sickness), Neosporin, anti-itch cream.
- Mosquito/bug repellent. Pre-treating clothes with a spray like Sawyers is a great alternative to wearing repellent spray.
- Travel journal/notepad and reading material
- Photography Equipment, charging device or extra batteries
- Large Ziploc baggies to carry wet clothing
- Wet Ones or other wipes
- Binoculars

## **\* TOUR ITINERARY \***

### **Day 1 - Wednesday (December 26)**

#### **Welcome to Ecuador (D)**

Upon arrival, you'll exit customs to be greeted by your driver. Travel to the beautiful Garden Hotel San Jose where you'll be welcomed and guided to your room. Guests arriving in the afternoon can enjoy the many onsite amenities at San Jose before joining the group for a Welcome Dinner and Orientation at about 7:00 PM. Meet your hosts and fellow travelers and ask any last minute questions about the week's itinerary.

### **Day 2 - Thursday (December 27)**

#### **TelefériQo Cable Ride to 14,000ft, Indigenous Market and Dinner in La Ronda (B, L, D)**

After breakfast we will travel into the heart of Quito at 9,500 feet where our adventure begins by taking a tram ride that takes us to 14,100 feet. At the top we'll walk and see volcanoes on the left and a panoramic view of the city of Quito on the right. This is a great place for pictures and hiking. Pending availability, you can also choose a horse ride to guide you through the trails. On a clear day you can observe all the famous surrounding volcanoes: Antisana (18,700 ft), Cayambe (18,725 ft), and Cotopaxi (19,347 ft).

Enjoy more history of Ecuador by seeing the traditional arts and crafts in the Indigenous Market. Then stroll the old cobblestone streets of La Ronda before enjoying a delicious Ecuadorian dinner.

### **Day 3 - Friday (December 28)**

Creating **life-changing** experiences and **unique** opportunities to **meet** the **world...together!!!**

## **Amazon Whitewater Rafting (B, L, D)**

Today's beautiful drive through the volcanic mountains takes us 2.5 hours away to the Amazon. The Quijos River offers an excellent 3-4 hour Level III rafting excursion with many challenging rapids that is famous with kayaking and rafting fans. Midway we'll stop for lunch and games in the sand. Then continue to experience this rafting tour in the beautiful tropical rainforest surrounded by rich flora and fauna.

After rafting we'll get a chance to see the powerful Cascada Magica, a giant waterfall where super adventurous people dive in to feel the force of the falls. After working up some big appetites, we'll be treated to an amazing dinner in a true rainforest cafe.

## **Day 4 - Saturday (December 29)**

### **Tumbaco – Swimming Pool and Chiche Canyon (B, L, D)**

This morning, enjoy some down time by sunbathing and rejuvenating by the pool and hot tub. We depart after lunch to the Chiche Canyon 10 minutes away. The canyon can best be described as a mini version of the Grand Canyon, popular with local cyclists with easy trails descending to a beautiful flowing river. Hike, Run or Bike on the trails for 2-3 hours. Bike is optional, must notify host for interest at beginning of tour.

## **Day 5 - Sunday (December 30)**

### **Mindo Cloud Rainforest Ziplining (B, L, D)**

This morning we depart a little earlier, to travel a 2.5 hour ride to the famous Mindo Cloud Rainforest. Mindo, one of the world's headquarters for rainforest preservation, is abundant with over 350 species of birds. It is an ideal place to snap photos, swim in lagoons and hike.

Enjoy a quick fruit snack before experiencing an amazing thrill ride, on 10 zip lines, 2000 meters in length that zip along at 100 meters above ground. At the end of the zipline experience a box lunch will be waiting for us in the picnic area.

Then take the Tarabita Skyway basket, a suspended metal cage for spectacular views of the Mindo River Valley. Enjoy a hike through the Rain Forest, visit one or more cascading waterfalls and possibly jump in for a swim in the Nambillo Lagoon.

## **Day 6 - Monday (December 31)**

### **Papallacta – Hot Thermal Springs and New Year's Eve Celebration (B, L, D)**

Enjoy a day of complete relaxation and rejuvenation after a late night in the city! We'll depart late in the morning for a ride to the Papallacta Thermal Springs. Bathe in the naturally odorless and volcanic heated spring pools of different sizes and temperatures in Papallacta. This soothing volcanic spring water contains sulfates, sodium, calcium, chloride and traces of magnesium that create a fully therapeutic feeling of rejuvenation and wellness. We return by 5:00 pm to give plenty of time to pack and share a fabulous farewell dinner.

Make sure you're well rested for a night you'll never forget! In the evening travel to Quito to celebrate New Year's Eve in the heart of the city with all the incredible and fun Ecuadorian traditions.

### **Day 7 - Tuesday (January 1)**

#### **Tour of the Equator and Quito Old Town (B, L, D)**

Kick off your New Year by exploring the Equator and learning about the natural phenomenon that make this such an amazing location. First we'll see the Temple Del Sol which provides a very spiritual aura and connection with the earth and sun. Here we will be able to learn more about the culture of indigenous Ecuadorians, the healing properties of essential oils, and view the beautiful art gallery of world renowned artist Cristobal Ortega. Next, visit the lookout point located at the edge of the Pululahua Crater to see the center of the volcanic crater and the

Then tour the always fun, interactive Intiñan Solar Museum. We will learn about the indigenous culture and witness the effects of the Equator's gravitational forces on water currents, personal strength, even balancing an egg on a nail! Finally you'll see Quito's Colonial district. The cobblestone streets and European style squares bring the past to life in its museums, convents, carved stone facades and golden altars of its many churches.

### **Day 8 - Wednesday (January 2)**

#### **Departure (B)**

Unfortunately the trip comes to an end but leaving us with wonderful photos and memories. Enjoy the hotel amenities until 12:00 PM or you can make arrangements at the hotel for a late check-out for a small charge. You'll be taken to the airport 3 hours before your scheduled departure. We look forward to having you, your family and your friends return.
